- Q. What is the best variety of oats to plant this early in the season?
- A. The main factor to consider if planting oats this early in the year is that it is best to plant a variety that is tolerable to warmer soil conditions. Pacific Seeds latest variety 'drover' thrives as an early Winter crop with a higher soil temperature tolerance and better early yield than any other variety. We currently have drover in stock for \$28.60 per 20kgs.
