LAYBY

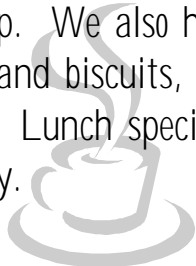
We offer layby facilities in all departments of the Co-op—please speak to a staff member if you wish to utilize this facility.
